In transport and logistics workflows and business processes are becoming increasingly digital. This has major effects on the competences required of transport and logistics workers.

Professional drivers are one of those groups of workers strongly affected by digitalisation and other major trends ahead of us. Their tasks, their role, their competence requirements and the way they learn are changing. Professional driving is now in a continuous transition process that is strongly driven by technical innovations such as autonomous driving. But what does this transition look like? The conference gathers experts and stakeholders representing transport and logistics, training and education, research and development, and policy and administration from across Europe to discuss the topic of digitalisation within transport and logistics and professional driving in particular.
